

Region 678 Volunteer Program – U5-U8

Mission: As an all-volunteer, non-profit organization, it is our goal of providing a soccer experience that enriches children's lives through a collective effort of all AYSO Region member families.

Purpose of program: To create opportunities for AYSO member families to assist the regional board in the operation of the regional fall soccer season, from pre-season through post-season. This program allows parents to contribute to the success of our program, while creating opportunities for interaction with the regional board and fellow member families and fostering a community spirit.

Non-Competitive Team (U5-U8) Requirement:

How to serve volunteer hours:

- **On games days when you are the HOME Team**, ONE team volunteer must report to the information tent 1-hour, 15 minutes before your schedule game for your job assignments. This will allow you to complete volunteer-hour commitment and be at your child's game with time to spare. Every team should supply volunteers when they are the HOME team.
- **Sign in at the Information Tent** and you will be assigned one of the jobs below. Assignments are on an as needed basis
- **We need 4 volunteers total at each hour:** One volunteer will man the information tent; one will check on garbage to ensure a clean and safe environment for play and monitor parking; and two volunteers will walk the fields, wearing the field monitor vest.

Volunteer opportunities:

- Pre-season field prep
- Field Monitoring
- Field Set up
- Field Break down
- Information tent
- Picture Day assistance
- Picture distribution
- Opening day check-in
- Trash Duty

Field set up (First Games of the day) — If you play the first game of the day, your team will be required to supply THREE volunteers to set up goals ONE HOUR BEFORE the start of the first game, line fields and other setup duties. These volunteers will be utilized as needed to ensure that all fields are set up in a timely manner.

Information Tent — Those staffing the information tent will assist with any questions and locate Board members as needed. There will be a contact sheet with all pertinent information for reference. A first aid kit, rules book and Lost & Found are located at the information tent.

Field Volunteers — Your job is to walk the fields, making sure that sidelines are well-behaved. See the Field Monitor duties hand out for full details on the Parents Volunteer page at ayso678.org

Field Breakdown (Last games of the day) Those teams playing the last game of the day will be required to tear down goals, flags and any other equipment and put it away properly in the storage container, as well as make sure the field is free of trash.
