

How to Fill Out a Lineup Card

(on the front, to filled out by the coach)

1. Region - 678
2. Division - GU12 (girls under 12), BU10, etc.
3. Team Number - each team will have a unique number within a division
4. Full Team Name -
5. Color of Jersey and Shorts
6. Player First and Last Names
7. List of Players in Numerical Order
8. Date, Time, and Field #

(on the back, to be filled out by the Officials)

1. Sportsmanship Points (2, 1, or 0)
2. Comments - for example, why sportsmanship points weren't awarded
3. Disciplinary Action Taken - Why Cautions or Send-Offs were issued
4. Referee Name and Team Number - Very important to Print your name so it is legible; also, put down the number/division of the team to which you wish to assign your referee points.
5. Linesperson's Name - (see #4)

During the game, the linesperson will keep track of substitutions and goalkeeper by quarter, placing a "X" in the appropriate quarter across from the player's name when they are out, or a GK or K when they are in as Keeper. AYSO Regulations state that all players must play a minimum of half the game (two quarters) unless they are ill or injured. However, Region 678 Regulations require that all players must play at least three quarters, and may play a maximum of half the game as goalkeeper (unless ill or injured). Line out all quarters for those players who are absent. If the linesperson notices a player who has only played two quarters is not entering the game in the last quarter, he/she should point out the "three quarter requirement" to the coach. However, neither the linesperson nor the center referee can force the coach to play that player – they can only note the fact on the game card under "comments".

It is also the duty of the linesperson to keep track of goals scored by your sideline, by putting a mark next to the player's name in the box corresponding to the first or second half of play. As noted on the previous page, it is very important that you print your name and the team number and division you are representing clearly on the back of game card. Failure to do so could result in you and your team not being credited with the volunteer points for that game.
