

Region 678 Field Volunteer Field Guide (Revised as of 8/3/11)



Rule #1: The board members in Orange Region shirts are here to handle any issues. If you are uncomfortable with any situation, please contact a board member immediately or go to the Information Tent.

Region 678 “KidZone” field rules (non-negotiable):



- No smoking on the fields. Smoking is only allowed outside park grounds.
- No dogs on the fields. Dogs must stay outside the park grounds.
- No yelling in anger or throwing objects on the field or along the sidelines
- No swearing or threats to players or coaches
- No cheering/coaching by Assistant Referees during games



- Zero Tolerance for referee abuse toward Youth Referees
- Always respect the field Referees
- Players/Coaches/Spectators who are ejected, must leave the park immediately.

General game information and guidelines:

- All coaching should be positive, instructive and encouraging
- All sideline behavior reflects good sportsmanship.
- No spectators or coaches behind the goals.
- Teams should leave the sidelines promptly to allow other teams to setup.
- Fans cheer, referees referee, and coaches coach
- Fun – not winning – is everything!!!

Frequently Asked Questions by spectators and coaches

Q. What field do I play on?

A. A field map is located at the Information Tent.

Q. What side does home/visitor sit on?

A. Home sits on North or West sidelines; Visitors on East and South. You must sit on your

Q. Can I take pictures from behind the goal?

A. Yes, with the referee’s permission. But you may not interfere, cheer or coach from that location.

Q. Where can I find a first aid kit?

A. A full array of first aid supplies is located at the Referee Tent

Q. Where do I report unruly behavior by spectators?

A. Go to the Information Tent and seek a board member in an orange shirt.

Q. Where can I get the referee some assistance for our game?

A. Go to the Referee Tent and seek a referee council member.
